

RABBI HERSCHEL GLUCK

BIOGRAPHICAL PROFILE



Rabbi Herschel Gluck OBE was born October 19, 1958 in London, England, United Kingdom to an Orthodox Jewish family. Both of his parents were Holocaust survivors who came to the United Kingdom as refugees from Austria.

Growing up, he witnessed his parents' lifelong work to rehabilitate other Holocaust survivors in his community. In 1981, he married Pessie Gluck and they raised eight children together.

He is Chairman of both the Arab-Jewish forum and the Muslim-Jewish forum, which he founded in 2000 to prevent and defuse tensions between communities. He is also Chairman of Northeast London's Shomrim, a Jewish volunteer neighborhood patrol group.

His mediation work extends to conflicts outside of Britain in his role as Deputy Chairman of the Next Century Foundation. This interview took place on July 18, 2017 in London, England, United Kingdom.
